A bursary in the amount of \$2000 will be provided to the successful recipient in honour of Morris Mercanti.

Individuals applying for the Edge Spirit Award must demonstrate the following values:

- 1) An Endurance to Overcome Obstacles
- 2) A Positive Attitude that Inspires Others
- 3) A Pursuit of Continuous Learning and Education
- 4) A Competitive Edge

Nominating Process:

- Nominations forms will be made available on the Charity of Hope website.
- Forms must be submitted by high school principals, guidance councillors or not-for-profit organizations.
- The runner-up in the nomination process will receive the **"BETTERMAN award."** This award is in honour of Tony DePaulo Jr who was a kind, giving person that had the ability to make everyone around him smile. This award is in the amount of \$500.00 and given to a deserving student (male or female) who exemplifies what it means to have hope in the face of adversity.
- Permission from the individual must be obtained before submitting the nomination.

• Each high school principal, guidance councillor or not-for-profit executive director will be asked to choose one nomination from their school/organization that best exemplifies the four values above.

• Nominations must be submitted to the Charity of Hope, by Friday, March 7th, 2025, to

• The Edge Spirit Award team of The Charity of Hope will review each application and submit 5 names to a selection committee

• The selection committee will then recommend the candidate that they feel best exemplifies the individual who best matches the criteria.

• The Board of Directors will advise the Executive Director to inform the school or Not-for-Profit director involved and the recipients will both be invited to attend the Charity of Hope Gala to receive the awards.

• A scoring scale from 1 to 5 (lowest to highest) will be assigned by the committee members and a winner will be selected.

• The winner and nominator will be contacted prior to the event and must be present at the event to accept the award.

• Due to the high volume of nominees, we are unable to contact everyone. If you have not received a phone call by April 4th, 2025, unfortunately, you were not selected.
